
Rava says: Job lived at the time of the spies whom Moses sent to scout the land of Canaan.

Rabbi Shmuel bar Naḥmani...said: Job never existed Rather, his story was a parable.


Rabbi Yoḥanan and Rabbi Elazar both say: Job was among those who ascended from the exile at the start of the Second Temple period.
