The Early Prophets - One Book, One Theme - class #41 The transition from Sefer Shmuel to Sefer Melachim

Introduction -

At first glance, Sefer Melachim appears to be a direct continuation of Sefer Shmuel – as it concludes the story of King David. In our shiur, we will consider why it is, and then conclude why it is not.

I. Baba Batra 15a – re: authorship of Sefer Melachim

יִרְמָיָה כַּתַב סִפְרוֹ וְסֵפֶר מְלָכִים וְקִינוֹת

Jeremiah wrote his own book, and the book of Kings, and Lamentations.

III. The Navi in chapter 11 & 12 – must be Achiya ha'Shiloni
Note the change in tone from positive to negative
But note the careful juxtaposition of parshiot
[most likely the work of a later Prophetic redactor!]

Final topics of chapter 10

Verses 14 thru 25 - great wealth (especially gold !)
But note positive conclusion:

Verses 26 thru 29 - the strength of his army (many horses!) Then chapter 11

Opening section – too many wives – leading Shlomo astray!

Note 10:21-26 - 'gold' in a positive light
