

Introduction -

This week, we return to our study of Sefer Melachim as a book, in an attempt to explain why Shlomo's construction of the Temple is so central to its opening chapters, while the Temple's destruction becomes the central topic of its final chapters.

I. Review of the time period of approx 400 years of Sefer Melachim The chart below will be the focus of our opening discussion

The X axis left to right is the year from time of Sefer Shmuel till end of Melachim the Y axis - the state of Monarchy, security, unity, economy, peace
