# The Early Prophets - One Book, One Theme - class #46 Yerovam's Revolt & the Split Kingdom - Part II - The Temple in Bet-El - A 'calf' or a 'cruv'?

#### Introduction -

Last week, we began our study of the 'split Kingdom', and the revolt of Yerovam from both a political & religious perspective. This week, we will examine the logic (& Biblical roots) of Yerovam's 'religious reform', i.e. the Temple he builds in Bet-El, and how this leads to the proliferation of "bamot" - the high places.

I. Review of the Midrash we discussed [Sanhedrin 102a], re: possiblity of a 'shared kingdom'

The verse states: "And after this matter, Jeroboam returned not from his evil way" (I Kings 13:33). To **what** event is the verse alluding, when it states: "After this matter"? Rabbi Abba says: It is after the Holy One, Blessed be He, grabbed Jeroboam by his garment, i.e., he sent prophets and implored him, and said to him:

Repent, and you and I and the son of Yishai will stroll together in the Garden of Eden.

Jeroboam said to Him: Who will walk in the lead? God said to Jeroboam: The son of Yishai will walk in the lead. Jeroboam said: **If so, I do not wish** to repent.
