Class #2 - Understanding chapter 25 in light of chapter 7
The first 'Political Prophecy' & its religious reason

Intro:

Today we begin our study of chapter 25, which includes what we will refer to as the first 'political prophecy'. To understand its importance, and why most of the nation claimed it was a 'false prophecy', we will study it in light of Yirmiyahu's key religious message in chapter 7.

First we will study the prophecy, and only afterward, consider its historic & prophetic setting:

I. Chapter 25

18 'Micah the Morashtite prophesied in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah; and he spoke to all the people of Judah, saying: Thus saith the LORD of hosts: Zion shall be plowed as a field, and Jerusalem shall become heaps, and the mountain of the house as the high places of a forest.

19 Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and entreat the favour of the LORD, and the LORD repented Him of the evil which He had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our own souls.

20 And there was also a man that prophesied in the name of the LORD, Uriah the son of Shemaiah of Kiriathjearim; and he prophesied against this city and against this land according to all the words of Jeremiah;

21 and when Jehoiakim the king, with all his mighty men, and all the princes, heard his words, the king sought to put him to death; but when Uriah heard it, he was afraid, and fled, and went into Egypt;
