

Introduction -

We conclude our summer study of Sefer Melachim with a topic that will also introduce our Elul topic, which relates to the topic of the Tanach's battle against idol worship, and the underlying Biblical concept of "malchiot" [Hashem's kingdom over His Creation].

We return to the 'showdown' between Eliyahu and the Baal Prophets on Mt. Carmel, and then we will trace the events thru the career of Elisha- leading to the revolt by Yehu.

Why did the people agree to kill the Baal Prophets?

- IV. The Elisha 'miracles' their unique nature Chapter:
 - 2 Fixes the water supply of Yericho
 - 3 saves a thirsty Israel army by providing a miracle with rain in the desert
 - 4a helps widow of fellow prophet providing oil

 To pay her debts to free her sons from slavery
 - 4b helps the barren Shunamite women
 With birth of child and his recovery
 - 4c helps fellow prophets fixing their spoiled food
 - 4d helps the people with miraculous food supply
 - 5 heals the tzaraat of Naaman general of Aram army
 - 6a helps his fellow prophets saving an axe from Jordan River
 - 6b helps provide military info to Israel army fighting Aram
 - 7 predicts victory over Aram during siege of Shomron
 - 8a Gaichazi [Elisha's servant] tells the King Elisha stories!

This ends the Elisha unit – first fulfilment of the 3 Eliyahu commands

- 8b Elisha appoint general Chazael King of Aram Fulfills 2nd Eliyahu command
- 9 Elisha sends his 'apprentice' to instigates Yehu's revolt Leading to Yehu becoming King of Israel - 3rd Eliyahu command
 - 10 Eliyahu wipes out the house of Achav & then wipes out the Baal Prophets

Everything Eliyahu wanted to accomplish, is finally accomplished
[but God's way – thanks to fulfilling the 3 commands from Mt. Carmel]

Baal worship is gone
Izevel is killed
The house of Achav is punished

V. Discussion: what are the political ramifications of Yehu's revolt Ties for Yehuda are cut – he killed the Judean king Ties with Tzidon [Lebanon] are cut – he killed Izevel He abandoned the 'Syrian front' - Aram takes over Ramot Gilad

The economic prosperity of Achav's kingdom is lost! How will the people 'blame' - Yehu or Elisha, or themselves?
